



CELEBRATING 100 YEARS

July 31, 1913 – The first organizational meeting of the Board of Trustees was held. It mentions the Marshal, Clerk and Trustees were present. Meetings were set for the first and third Monday of each month.

August 4, 1913 – The first regular meeting of the Town Board was held. The Marshal was listed as attending. The Marshal's salary was set at \$45 per month. Marshals served on a part-time basis and also normally worked on the streets.

August 18, 1913 – At a regular Board meeting, a bond was set for the Marshal and the Town Clerk. Joseph H. Gruebel as appointed to serve as Marshal through January 1, 1914. He continued to serve as Marshal for 22 years.

March 16, 1914 – Ordinance #16 was established, which authorized the Marshal to appoint a Deputy Marshal with no compensation for that position.

May 1977 – First full-time Marshal appointed.

Now – Currently have 3 full-time officers.
